

Congress center „Danubia“



Silver Lake is one of the most famous excursion areas in Serbia. The lake is actually a branch of the Danube River, which was in 1971st converted with embankment in the upper stream, so the coastal Rama rit was protected from the groundwater. The lake is located in the municipality of Veliko Gradište (2.5 km away from the town) and has a very good tourist location because it is on the intersection of important roads and close to the economically developed cities (120km distance from Belgrade, 34km from Pozarevac and 60km from Smederevo). "Silver Star" is ship designed for tourist boat cruise along the Danube. Boat capacity is up to 300 people (indoor and outdoor area). Cruise ship „Silver Star“ will give you an unforgettable experience and a stunning view of the Danube coast. „Silver Star“ usually sails on two regular lines: to the mouth of the river Pek and back (1,5 hours of sailing); to the Golubac Fortress and back (3,5 hours of sailing). Historical and religious sights of Braničevo District. The Tuman Monastery.

The Tuman Monastery (Serbian: Манастир Туман) is a 14th-century Serbian Orthodox monastery in eastern Serbia, in the municipality of Golubac. It belongs to the Serbian Orthodox Eparchy of Braničevo. It is also referred to as the Tuman Monastery.

The church is dedicated to the Saint Archangel Gabriel. As of 2018, the monastery has six monks and one nun, which makes it the largest one in the Braničevo District. Because of the several historical healers who dwelled in the monastery, Tuman has been called "Ostrog of the Đerdap".

The monastery is situated in the valley of the river of Tumanska reka, 12 km (7.5 mi) south-east of Golubac. It is located in the village of Snegotin, though it is outside of the village itself, in the forested, secluded depression area of the north-west section of the Severni Kučaj mountain. South of the monastery rises the 591-metre-high (1,939 ft) peak of Crni Vrh Tumanski ("Black Peak of Tuman"). The forests which encircle the monastery are estimated to be over a century old.

PAPER SUBMISSION

Submitted papers will be orally presented by specified schedule. The term for each presentation is listed in the program. Posters will be available to all participants during the Symposium, according to the wishes of the author. Installation of the posters will be on Friday, 31st of May, from 08.00 to 08.30 AM. Accommodation of the participants is at Silver Lake in Veliko Gradište, where the Symposium will be held. All submitted papers will be published in its entirety in the Book of Proceedings of the 17th Symposium. Gala dinner is on Friday, 31st June. Price per guest is 26 EUR.
